Language Arts

This week the students were assessed on the following standards: CCSS RL2.2, RL2.3 and RL2.9. Students had to retell one of the stories, and they were given the choice of doing so through writing or orally using the app RECAP. During guided reading we spent time comparing/ contrasting story elements. We used different versions of The Three Little Pigs and also a varitey of Cinderella stories in order to do these comparisons.

Math

Addition and Subtraction with regrouping is the focus of our new math unit. We will cover the following standards: 2.NBT.7 Add within 1000 using concrete models or drawings and strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction; relate the strategy to a written method.

2.NBT.5 Fluently add and

subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.

2.NBT.6 Add up to four two-digit numbers using strategies based on place value and properties of operations.

2.NBT.9 Explain why

addition and subtraction strategies work.
